

Directions to the Kennedy lab in Diehl Hall (BioMedical Library), lower level, J corridor, Room J-116

From US 94 take the Huron exit and rapidly move to the left lane because soon after you leave the off ramp you must turn left at the first stop light onto Fulton Ave.

Take Fulton for a few blocks, through the Oak St. light; continue straight about 2 more city blocks to the Harvard St. stop sign.

Go right on Harvard 2 blocks and cross Washington Ave. The Washington Ave. parking ramp is on your left and Commons hotel is on your right. You need to drive counterclockwise $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around the ramp to eventually turn left into the ramp (left at Beacon Street traffic signal, left again at Union Street stop sign, then left into the ramp.)

Park and go to the SW corner of the ramp to a bank of 3 elevators. Go to the Tunnel (lowest) level.

The tunnel crosses under Washington Ave. and enters into the 2nd floor of Moos tower (it hosts the Dentistry School). As you enter you will be looking down a very long wide corridor.

Go straight down the hallway almost to the end. About $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way along, you will pass the “Freshii” cafeteria on your right. On the wall on your left, across from the cafeteria entrance, there is a wall phone. If you call us **625-1431** or if busy **626-6148** (same place) we will come to get you.



Or, if you are brave and want to find us by yourself (it isn't hard) continue the last few feet to the end of the long hallway that you have traveled. You will be facing a Wall of Scholarship.

Turn left. After walking 20-30 feet you will encounter the wide entry to the Diehl Hall BioMedical library on your right.

Turn and walk toward the library door. Before you reach the door on your right you will find an elevator and stairs. Take the stairs or elevator down one floor to the lower level. Go through the brown door at the bottom of the stairs, past the elevator then through a red door. (Notice the restrooms to your left). Turn right then immediately through another red door to enter a long right-to-left hallway. Turn left down the hallway to the 1st (yet another) red door on your right.

A small wooden block above the door is labeled J to signify J corridor. On your left there is a little sign about a Nerve test. Enter and you will be standing on a long blue hallway carpet runner. My office is J-116. It is on the right about half way down the corridor just past an open corridor door.

Most of the doors distal to that door are part of the Kennedy lab so just ask or shout. If we are at coffee we will be further down the runner on the right in room J-108.
